## ITINERARY

### Adventure Camp Part One (June 18-June 22)

This is an entirely off campus program with a new activity beginning at a new location each day. All locations are less than 15 minutes from Princeton Academy. Campers need to bring the appropriate gear to each day's activity in addition to two water bottles, packed lunch, and sunscreen. Mr. Deisher and Kevin Dowling will be the counselors.

**Monday, June 18 - Fishing at Rosedale Park:** There are two lakes and a stream that we can try. Please bring fishing rods and tackle. The day will include a casting lesson and competition for accuracy. Meet at the parking lot next to the lake at 9am.

**Tuesday, June 19 - Mountain biking at Mercer County Park:** Bring a mountain bike, helmet and gloves. Drop off at 9am and pick up at 3pm at the Marina parking lot.

**Wednesday, June 20 - Hiking/Geocaching at Mountain Lakes Preserve:** Bring sturdy shoes to explore this hidden gem. Drop off at 9 and pick up at 3 at the parking lot on Mountain Road.

**Thursday, June 21 - Fishing at Carnegie Lake:** Bring fishing rods and lures. Drop off at 9am and pick up at 3pm at Washington Road.

**Friday, June 22 - Canoeing/Kayaking the canal:** The cost for the rental is included in the camp. Drop off at 9am and pick up at 3pm at Turning Basin Park on Alexander Road.

### Adventure Camp Part Two (July 2-July 6) *Not including July 4th*

This session of adventure camp includes the overnight to Tohickon Valley Campground in beautiful upper Bucks County, Pennsylvania. Campers need to bring the appropriate gear to each day's activity in addition to two water bottles, packed lunch, and sunscreen. Mr. Deisher and Kevin Dowling will lead the activities.

**Monday, July 2 - Hiking/Geocaching at Baldpate Mountain:** Bring sturdy shoes. Meet at the parking lot on Fiddler's Creek Road at 9AM.

**Tuesday, July 3 - Mountain Biking at Six Mile Run Park:** Bring a mountain bike, helmet, and gloves.

**Thursday, July 5 - Friday, July 6 - Overnight camping trip to Tohickon Valley Campground:** On Thursday, we will go tubing down the Delaware River. Bring a swimming suit, sleeping bag and a tent if you have one. For dinner we will have hot dogs and whatever fish we catch. You have to try Coach D's French toast with maple syrup cooked over the campfire. Drop off at 9am on Thursday and pick up at 3pm on Friday.
